f Aussies have heard of Houston it is most likely because of the failed Apollo 13 Moon mission and those memorable words: "Houston, we have a problem." Texas's fourth-largest city,

population 2.2 million, is home to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Johnson Space Centre – location of mission control.

Space nuts can tour the Johnson Centre but I'm in Houston for a different experience.

What a lot of people don't know about the city is that it is one of the world's best arts destinations.


Houston is awash in oil money and a lot of that has been channelled into


the arts. This city has its own Museum District - a collection of 19 world-class cultural institutions all within a short distance of one another.

Just as impressively, it has a vibrant theatre scene. The downtown theatre district is home to nine professional arts organisations including the world-renownedHouston Ballet.

HERE ARE 10 TOP PICKS: THE MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS **1001 BISSONNET ST**

Houston's leading art institution is so big it takes up more than 100 galleries across two buildings. Don't miss the Monet Water Lilies, a breathtaking

THE MENIL COLLECTION **1533 SUL ROSS ST**


This permanent display of treasures owned by John and Dominique de Menil takes up an entire neighbourhood. The main collection includes major Surrealist works by Max Ernst and Rene Magritte, as well as contemporary masters Andy Warhol and Robert Rauschenberg, and is housed in a sleek structure designed by architect Renzo Piano. Across the road is a whole building dedicated to Cy Twombly. Nearby Richmond Hall is filled with a massive Dan Flavin light sculpture. MENIL.ORG

ROTHKO CHAPEL 3900 YUPON ST

The Menils also commissioned this sacred space featuring 14 massive dark canvases by abstract expressionist painter Mark Rothko. This is a place to take your shoes off, adopt the lotus pose, and sit in quiet contemplation. Barnett Newman sculpture Broken Obelisk stands in front of the chapel. ROTHKOCHAPEL.ORG

THE HOUSTON BALLET **WORTHAM THEATRE CENTRE** Aussie boy makes good. Stanton Welch AM, former resident

choreographer with the Australian



Ballet, has been the artistic director of the Houston Ballet since 2003. During my visit, I see Welch's bold interpretation of Madame Butterfly. His Cinderella and La Bayadere are also justly celebrated. HOUSTONBALLET.ORG

JAMES TURRELL 'TWILIGHT **EPIPHANY' SKYSPACE RICE UNIVERSITY**

Wow. That is pretty much the feeling you'll have as you gaze upwards through a central aperture in Turrell's massive pyramidal structure in the lead-up to sunrise or sunset. Turrell's

coloured-light sequence, which plays out across the pavilion's roof, interacts with the aperture's natural light to hypnotic effect. SKYSPACE.RICE.EDU

BAYOU BEND 6003 MEMORIAL DRIVE

For 50 years, oil heiress and philanthropist Ima Hogg, "the first lady of Texas", collected rare American paintings and decorative arts. They are housed in her home where each room is devoted to a different style. The house is surrounded by nine different gardens

MCCLAIN GALLERY 2242 RICHMOND AVENUE

Houston is home to some amazing commercial contemporary galleries including Moody Gallery, Barbara Davis Gallery and the Anya Tish Gallery, but my pick is Robert McClain's beautiful space which has exhibited Picasso, Robert Motherwell and Alex Katz and a range of fascinating group shows. HOUSTON GRAND OPERA

WORTHAM THEATRE CENTRE Ever since it was founded in 1955, the Grand Opera has mixed traditional works such as Faust and Verdi's Requiem with exciting new commissions such as the world premiere of It's a Wonderful Life, based on the classic Frank Capra movie. HOUSTONGRANDOPERA.ORG

CULLEN SCULPTURE GARDEN MONTROSE BOULEVARD AT BISSONNET ST

Across the road from the Museum of Fine Arts is this tranquil oasis. The gardens are created by sculptor Isamu Noguchi and include major works by Henri Matisse, Auguste Rodin, Louise Bourgeois, David Smith and Dan Graham.

RIENZI **1406 KIRBY DRIVE**

The former home of philanthropists Carol Sterling Masterson and Harris Masterson III is now the setting for a knockout collection of European decorative arts, paintings, furnishings, porcelain and miniatures. MFAH.ORG/RIENZI

My Top 10 list hardly scratches the surface of Houston's cultural drawcards. The Alley Theatre, Rice Gallery, Centre for Photography and Jung Centre stand with a batch of top-drawer museums dedicated to the Holocaust, health, natural science, African-American culture, contemporary craft and Asian heritage. There is also a 22ha zoo.
